

STTM MARKET OPERATOR SERVICE (MOS) ALLOCATION COSTS – 2016-17

1. BACKGROUND

In line with the National Gas Rules (NGR), STTM pipeline operators have provided AEMO with an invoice for their actual 2016-17 MOS allocation service costs.

AEMO has published the 2016-17 invoices. There were no comments received.

Australian Energy Regulator (AER) is then required to make a determination on the invoices. This has been received by AEMO. The AER advised they are satisfied with the MOS allocation costs submitted by SEAGas, Epic Energy, Jemena and the APA Group.

The table below sets out the estimate provided, the invoices received and the final amounts paid to each of the pipeline operators.
