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1. Introduction

These release notes are for GBB 1.6 AEMO Patch (build 1.6-289-4).

On 30th September 2015, the Minister for Energy announced that the majority of the IMO's functions will be transferred to the Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO). These functions include the operation of the Wholesale Electricity Market and the administration of the Gas Bulletin Board WA. This transfer will take effect on Monday 30th November 2015 at 8.00 am.

This GBB (WA) release supports the announcement and effect of transfer occurring at 8:00am, 30th November 2015. This release also facilitates a number of new connection points which will become effective at a later date.

2. Australian Energy Market Operator Branding

2.1 GISP-914: GBB Rebranding for transition to AEMO

Rebrand the homepage

Changes have been made to integrate the AEMO logo and style guide into the GBB (WA) to ensure consistency across websites operated by AEMO. Users will continue to be able to access GBB (WA) with their current credentials. The new GBB (WA) screen will appear as follows:



Rebrand three GBB reference documents

The GBB API, GBB User Guide, and the GBB Participant Submission Interface documents have been rebranded to AEMO.

Rebrand GBB registration forms

All GBB (WA) registration forms have been rebranded to AEMO.

GBB Terms and Conditions

The GBB terms and conditions have had all references to IMO changed to AEMO. This is for the trial, EMF and Production terms and conditions:
