For the avoidance of doubt, this proposal applies to distribution connected facilities (under the distribution operational coordination procedure) and to DTS connected facilities (under the gas scheduling procedures).	Red and Lumo consider 5TJ/day an appropriate threshold.
Question 2: Do participants consider the 5TJ/d constraint materiality threshold for sending a SWN is appropriate as AEMO already publishes all constraints at schedule approval? For the avoidance of doubt, this proposal applies to distribution connected facilities (under the distribution operational coordination procedure) and to DTS connected facilities (under the gas scheduling procedures).	Red and Lumo support the 5TJ/d threshold for SWN as it ensures participants are not provided with notifications below a level relevant to the market.

2.1. Declared transmission system overview	Red and Lumo request clarification of the linepack zones and whether they do actually align to the WZ or only 'broadly' align with the WZ' as suggested? The Glossary defines Linepack as 'The amount of energy in the gas stored in the declared transmission system' and since the DTS is bounded by the WZ, it would follow that the WZ define the linepack zones, rather than 'broadly'.	The linepack zones within the DTS include the Gippsland, Melbourne, Geelong, Ballarat and Northern zones, and broadly align to the WZs described in Table 4.
