

28 March 2024 Notice to all Registered STTM Sydney Hub Participants.

This Notice is to advise Participants on AEMO's decision to approve amendments to the:

• STTM Procedures

AEMO has implemented a procedure change to facilitate the removal of the Rosalind Park gas production facility's custody transfer point from clause 2.2(d) of the STTM Procedures.

This Procedure change is to reflect the physical removal of the receipt point to Jemena Gas Networks distribution network.

This procedure change was implemented as an expedited Procedure change under NGR135EF(2), reflecting that the change was non-material being the removal of a defunct custody transfer point. The timeline of the procedure change was:

- IIR publication date: 27 February 2024
- IIR consultation submissions due: 19 March 2024
- Decision published: 28 March 2024
- Effective Date of Procedures: 22 April 2024

As required under Rule 135EF of the NGR, Participants and other interested parties were invited to submit comments to AEMO on the implementation of these Procedure changes. No submissions were received in response to the IIR.

As required under Rule 135EF of the NGR, AEMO is publishing this Notice of Decision regarding the Procedures. The effective date of these Procedure changes is 22 April 2024.

AEMO has approved the proposed amendments (Attachment A) of this Notice.

The key changes are summarised below:

STTM Procedures

• The change to the STTM Procedures is to section 2.2(d):

[DELETED] custody transfer point 4: the connection between the respective pipelines identified in Pipeline Licence No. 30 (Rosalind Park CSM) and Pipeline Licence No. 1 (Wilton to Horsley Park) issued under the Pipelines Act 1967 of New South Wales, being the Rosalind Park Receipt Point located at chainage KP 15.3 of the Wilton to Horsley Park natural gas pipeline.
