This notice informs all Registered Participants and interested parties (**Consulted Persons**) that AEMO is conducting a consultation on the Constraint Formulation Guidelines (**CFG**) and the Schedule of Constraint Violation Penalty Factors (**SCVPF**) for the NEM.

This consultation is being conducted under clause 3.8.10(c) of the National Electricity Rules (**NER**), in accordance with the Rules consultation requirements detailed in clause 8.9 of the NER.

Matter under Consultation

AEMO needs to develop and consult on a new version of the Constraints Formulation Guidelines and an updated version of the Schedule of Constraint Violation Penalty Factors.

AEMO would particularly welcome consideration and feedback on the following matters described below:

- Updates to the CFG for the 1 second FCAS to be introduced in October 2023.
- Updating the SCVPF with a new value for the 1 second FCAS services the proposed value is
 9.
- Updates to the CFG to meet the Integrating energy storage systems rule changes (due to come into effect in June 2024.

AEMO has also proposed a number of minor drafting changes to the CIR Guidelines to improve readability, remove redundant text and transition to an updated format.

In your submission, you may request a meeting with AEMO to discuss the matter under consultation, stating why you consider a meeting is necessary or desirable.

If appropriate, meetings may be held jointly with other Consulted Persons. Subject to confidentiality restrictions, AEMO will generally make details of matters discussed at a meeting available to other Consulted Persons and may publish them.
