## 1. Welcome, Introduction, Attendance and Apologies – V. Mouchaileh (slide 3-5)

Participants were welcomed and the purpose of the meeting was confirmed

## 2. Minutes and Actions from Previous Meeting - V. Mouchaileh (slides 6-7)

The actions from meeting Executive Forum #12 have been reviewed and updated. Please refer to the meeting pack.

#### 3. Program Update - R. Leung (slides 8 - 11)

Slide 9 shows the status for each of the 5MS systems workstreams as presented at the PCF on 19 May 2021. It was noted that the Retail go-live date of 31 May was Red and would not be met. Therefore, the Retail go-live had been rescheduled to the backup date of 21 June 2021. AEMO is continuing to collaborate with industry to manage the risks and impacts of the change and date and put mitigation measures in place to meet 1 October 2021.

The overall program timeline was presented as set out on slide 10 and the changes to milestone dates as a result of the Retail go-live reschedule were presented. It was noted that the Retail workstream remained Amber.

Slide 11 shows the readiness dashboard with information gathered from industry through readiness reporting round 7 and updated to reflect current information. AEMO's readiness is showing as Amber as a result of the status for Retail workstream noting the successful implementation of the settlements and bidding platforms. The essential industry capabilities for 5MS rule commencement are on track, with both generation and metering components on track noting individual participant exceptions. Overall the 5MS rule commencement date of 1 October 2021 is Green, with heightened risk profile highlighted. The line item titled "other industry capabilities" shows the status of industry against the activities that are not essential for 5MS commencement. While some individuals are reporting some activities as at risk, this is not systemic and relates more to GS Soft Start activities therefore does not put 5MS at risk.

It was noted that while the amount of time between Market Trial completion and 5MS rule commencement has reduced as a result of the Retail deferral, AEMO is comfortable that there is sufficient time for transition or



preparatory activities. It was also noted that the key tests are related to the transition week which is scheduled early in Market Trial and that any issues and defects that may occur will be remediated as they arise rather than waiting until the completion of Market Trial.

## 4. Retail Status Update - G. Windley (slides 12 - 117)

AEMO provided the key reasons for the delay to the Retail go-live as set out on slide 13.

The current status of the Retail workstream was provided against the Checkpoint Criteria for go-live, as set out on slide 14. It was reported that the status of the workstream remains Amber.

AEMO provided clarity on the data migration issues. A production data fix was required in the current MSATS solution for the CATS table and a corresponding change was required in MDM. These activities needed to be completed prior to data migration.

AEMO provided an update on the Retail test program. It was noted that functionality had been identified that could be deployed in an additional drop if it was not ready for 21 June or if it was putting the go-live of 21 June at risk. This includes the functionality for NCONUML. AEMO confirmed that there was a likelihood this functionality could be delayed by a week or two. An update would be provided to the PCF at the session on 4 June and confirmation would be provided on 14 June as part of the Go/No-Go notice.

AEMO confirmed that although the status for 21 June was Amber, a path forward had been identified that would allow for 21 June go-live.

### 5. Contingency Planning - P. Carruthers (slide 18 -23)

AEMO provided an overview of the approach to developing the contingency plan and the discussion with and feedback received from the PCF.

It was noted that the first approach would be to identify areas where the timeline could be compressed so that 1 October could be achieved.

AEMO noted that the 5MS Program were working with participants to understand the impact of compressing the timeline. NCONUML has emerged as a key pressure should this approach need to be taken.

AEMO confirmed that the conclusion on contingency planning would be provided to the PCF at the session on 17 June and that this would include the approach to compressing the timeline to maintain 1 October should 21 June be missed.

AEMO presented the high-level impacts to the regulatory implementation roadmap of 5MS not commencing on 1 October 2021 as set out on slide 22.

AEMO noted that there was a high degree of confidence the Retail platform would work for both 5MS changes and Customer Switching once the testing was complete. Customer Switching is an MSATS CATS only change and does not impact MDM for 5MS.
