Last Consumer Change Date (LCCD) Update

AEMO advised that MSATS LCCD obligations has commenced as of 1 November and noted that two
issues have been raised and are currently under investigation. Further details relating to the LCCD

4 March 2024 Metering Exemptions Testing Approach

(Slides 9-13)

- AEMO advised that Industry test has commenced from 4 October and will continue until end of January 2024. Formal industry testing will be run from 29 January to 1 March 2024 with further details outlined on slide 10 of the accompanying slide pack.
- AEMO outlined the industry test requirements on slide 11 of the accompanying slide pack and noted that the draft Go-Live plan for March 2024 is due on 8 January 2024 with the final version due 6 February 2024. AEMO noted that production effective date for Metering Exemptions is 4 March 2024.
- AEMO provided a brief update on the B2M schema to r44 in MSATS with further details outlined on slide
 13 of the accompanying slide pack.
