Addendum No 2 – Minimum RERT

19 August 2019

On 7 August 2019, AEMO released a request for Expressions of Interest (EOI) seeking expressions of interest for RERT Panel members for potential reserve providers in New South Wales (including Australian Capital Territory), Queensland, South Australia, Tasmania and Victoria who may be able to provide reserve energy on short and medium notice as part of a RERT panel.

It has since come to our attention of some errors in the EOI and the SN/MN RERT Panel Agreement and some amendments have been made to documentation as follows:

- To be eligible, the minimum reserve must be at least 5MW and not 10MW as appears in some parts of those document.
- Certain MN RERT reserve schedules in the SN/MN RERT Panel Agreement has been amended to add item 6.5 relating to the availability charge rebate scheme to be consistent with other MN RERT reserve schedules. Consequential amendments have been made to the charging and security provisions.
- Other miscellaneous clarifying amendments have also been made.

The EOI and the SN/MN RERT Panel Agreement have been updated and posted to the RERT Tender webpage. The updated version of the SN/MN RERT Panel Agreement is released in a marked up .pdf version (showing all changes to date) and a clean .docx version.
