

Verification and Testing of Facilities for the Purposes of the Reserve Capacity Mechanism

21 September 2006 to 31 March 2007

- The IMO has undertaken verification and testing of all generation Facilities that have Reserve Capacity Obligations greater than zero (ie all Scheduled Generators) for the period from Market Start through to 31 March 2007.
- The majority of Facilities were verified through observation that they had met their Reserve Capacity Relevant Level during normal operations.
- Reserve Capacity tests were undertaken by System Management, on behalf of the IMO on the following facilities:
