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Appendix A – Item 4.1.7 (007)

The removal of End Dates on Update CR's means that Participants cannot appropriately update data in Churn Scenarios.

Example. TCAUSTM has a BASIC meter with suffix 11. INTEG M removes their meter and adds a COMMS4 meter with Suffix N1. The transfer of MDP occurs before TCAUSTM have added N1 into MSATS. TCAUSTM is required by the Market Churn rules to install N1 into MSATS for the Churn period.

TCAUSTM now has no way of updating this information into MSATS.

- A CR4001 will fail if it is End Dated under the new market rules
- A CR4001 will fail if it is open ended as TCAUSTM is not an open ended contract
- A CR4051 cannot be used because the N1 has never existed.

The market needs to address these points.
