Hi Peter,

The City of Salisbury would like the option of installing LED luminaires manufactured by Unilumin Group, in future subdivisions or street lighting upgrades. We understand that in order to utilise these luminaires on a public lighting energy tariff, they need to be added to the AEMO load table and we therefore formally request the following luminaires be listed:

- 28LED UNISTWF – 0009 Total Power consumption 27.7W
- 56LED UNISTWF – 0008 Total Power consumption 72W
- 120LED UNISTAA – 01-01 Total power consumption 115W

In addition, the City of Salisbury will issue a request to the SA electricity distributor to have these luminaires listed on their approved public lighting list for utilisation in public lighting schemes.
