

Reliability and Emergency Reserve Trader (RERT) contracted on Wednesday 27 November 2024



On 27th November 2024, AEMO entered into eighteen short notice reserve contracts in response to a forecast Lack of Reserve 2 (LOR 2) condition in New South Wales. The forecast LOR 2 condition was triggered by forecasted high temperatures and a higher system demand for the New South Wales region.

AEMO will publish further details in the quarterly RERT report due in February 2025.
