



Interim Reliability Reserves (IRR) contracted from Wednesday 29 January 2025



In the 2024 Electricity Statement of Opportunities AEMO determined that in summer 2024-25 expected unserved energy was forecast to exceed the interim reliability measure in the region of South Australia. As a result, in accordance with clauses 3.20 and 11.128 of the National Electricity Rules, to address the interim reliability exceedance in this region in 2024-25, AEMO sought to procure interim reliability reserves (IRR).

As reported previously, AEMO entered into reserve contracts with three providers to provide a total of 17 MW of IRR from 1 January 2025.

Following the commencement of the *National Electricity Amendment (South Australian jurisdictional derogation - Interim reliability reserve eligibility) Rule 2025 No. 1*, AEMO has entered into an additional reserve contract for the provision of IRR in South Australia, as set out below.
