

These are the release notes for WEM PaSS 2.0 (Build 2.0-814-2). This release includes a major upgrade to the underlying framework of WEM PaSS to .NET 5. In addition, a number of internal and external minor bug fixes and improvements have been addressed.


## 2 .NET 5 Upgrade

The underlying framework of WEM PaSS has undergone a major upgrade to .NET 5. This upgrade allows AEMO to align WEM PaSS to have the same .NET framework as the recently upgraded RCM Portal. Comprehensive regression testing was undertaken to ensure that existing functionality would not be impacted. No Market Participant impact is expected.

# 3 Removal of 'Try it Out' Functionality in Swagger UI

The 'Try it Out' functionality in the AEMO Prudential API Swagger UI¹ has been removed. This functionality was removed for security reasons. Swagger UI will be upgraded from version 1.0 to version 3.0 as part of the .NET 5 upgrade.

In addition to the functionality above, the following issues have been resolved in this release.

SPARTA-913	Updated the phone number shown on Rule Participant Invoices to be WA Market Operations.	Phone number changed to 1300 989 797 Option 1.
PRUD-47	Fix an outstanding bug that impacts the sorting of 'Outstanding Amount %' in WEM PaSS.	Set the default sorting order of the column 'Outstanding Amount %' descending.
PRUD-63	Improvements to Credit Limit functionality to remove manual push for effective date in WEM PaSS.	Implement an automated worker to update Credit Limits at 02:00 for the upcoming Trading Day.
PRUD-52	Implemented the ability for WA Market Operations to update Credit Limit determinations and supporting documentation in 'bulk' to reduce risk.	Introduced a system to upload and validate Credit Limit determinations in WEM PaSS.
MOSMI-82	Improvements to Credit Limit and Credit Support monitoring.	Implement an internal check for when a Rule Participant's Credit Limit > Credit Support.
