Notice to all Registered Victorian Declared Wholesale Gas Market Participants.

This Notice is to advise Participants on AEMO's decision to approve amendments to the Wholesale Market Electronic Communication Procedure Technical Documents, that define DWGM market systems, including the:

- Webexchanger User Guide
- DWGM Participant Build Pack; and
- User Guide to MIBB Reports.

Amendments to the Technical Documents can be made by AEMO under the Wholesale Market Electronic Communication Procedures section 2.5(b) in the event the Technical Document change is a result of a Rule or Wholesale Market Procedure change.

Market Participants were consulted, under the ordinary Procedure Change Consultative Process prescribed under Rule 135EE of the National Gas Rules (NGR) which concluded on 6 May 2021, on the "[Implementation of 2020 DWGM enhancement rule changes](#)" which resulted in the substantive changes to these Technical Documents.

The Capacity Certificates can be used for tie breaking purposes in the Victorian Declared Wholesale Gas Market from gas day 1 January 2023. This update to the Technical Documents is to:

- Implement the removal of AMDQ and AMDQ Credit Certificates from market systems
- Release the last outstanding MIBB reports from the DWGM Enhancements project.

In addition, the release also incorporates updates to the MIBB reports for Curtailment Tables and Curtailment Instructions required by the consultation on the [Gas Load Curtailment and Gas Rationing and Recovery Guidelines](#). The MIBB Reports related to this Procedure change go live 7 December 2022.

AEMO has approved the proposed amendments (Attachment A) of this Notice as required to implement the market systems changes.

The key changes are summarised below:

Webexchanger User Guide changes include:

- Updated to remove the sections related to AMDQ and AMDQ Credit Certificates which include the screens for Injection Hedge Nominations, Agency Injection Hedge Nominations, Agency injection Hedge Nomination Confirmation and AMDQ Nomination.
- These changes become effective on 1 January 2023.

DWGM Participant Build Pack changes include:

- Updated to remove the sections related to AMDQ and AMDQ Credit Certificates which include the screens for Injection Hedge Nominations, Agency Injection Hedge

Nominations, Agency injection Hedge Nomination Confirmation and AMDQ Nomination.

- These changes become effective on 1 January 2023.

MIBB User Guide changes include changes for the implementation of Capacity Certificates, changes to incorporate the updated Curtailment tables and some minor editorial amendments. As such AEMO is publishing a User Guide to MIBB Reports for use from 7 December 2022 and 1 February 2023 to account for the different report decommissioning dates shown discussed below.

Changes associated with implementation of Capacity Certificates on 1 January 2023.
