Does your organisation have an alternate proposal for implementation?	We would like ICF_016 Reinstate the MC Objection of "BadParty" for Victorian SMALL NMI's to be retained with an effective date of 1 May 2022. With an effective date of 7 November our preference is that the industry cutover occurs on Sunday 6 November. This will minimise the impact to business as usual operations for participants and the market as a whole. This will allow Sunday shakeout to occur in readiness for Monday commencement.
