### Program update and current activities



### AEMO program

- Overall Green, MDM Go-Live and associated milestones have been rebaselined, re-planning activity is now complete.
- The Program is now entering a critical few months of delivery, with a large number of build items to be delivered across all workstreams
- Severe weather event has impacted the TCS Kolkata teams in addition to COVID-19.

#### Systems

- Staging environment has been updated with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Settlements drop and 2<sup>nd</sup> Dispatch drop on 15 May.
- Replanning for Retail is complete. The program is on track to deliver to the two upcoming Staging deployment dates.
- r39 Schema discussion held with market participants, understanding of n-1 requirement conveyed to participants.



#### Readiness

- Deferral scenario, incorporating MDM milestone shifts discussed with TFG, RWG and ITWG,
- Readiness Report # 2 results published. Round 2 has seen increase in response rate from participants. Follow up with participants who have indicated program issues to understand remediation requirements

## Proposed Changes to Settlements and Bidding Go-Live

• At PCF#21 AEMO proposed bringing the Settlements and Bidding Go-Lives forward.

### <u>Rationale</u>

- This was proposed as a risk mitigation measure for the following risks:
  - The risk of three significant cutovers all in a similar time
  - The solution going first (Retail) carries the most technology risk
- Both solutions are tracking on schedule for deployment into pre-production in November 2020. If the software is ready to be deployed and all entry criteria to deployment is met, AEMO should look to deliver the changes and close down program streams.
- AEMO sought feedback from the PCF and RWG on the proposed changes (next slide)

### Next Steps

- AEMO has reviewed all feedback and has continued discussions internally to consider the impact on the AEMO business
- There have been a number of risks identified with bringing the solutions forward e.g. proximity to other scheduled AEMO activities and resourcing constraints
- Therefore, AEMO is not proposing to change the date for the Settlements and Bidding Go-Live milestones. They will remain, as scheduled, on 01-Apr-21
- However, AEMO is proposing to add the risk of having three major go-lives in close proximity to the Industry Risks and Issues Register

2	What other changes to the proposed deployment timeframe would assist in mitigating any impacts?	<ul> <li>Three responded "no impact" and a further three indicated:</li> <li>1) It would be helpful if all APIs were made available as soon as possible,</li> <li>2) The extended testing window was suitable, and</li> <li>3) A delay in bilateral testing affects planning for testing resources.</li> </ul>
3	Does the proposal to bring forward the implementation of the 5MS bidding platform to November impact your 5MS program?	<ul> <li>Three responded "no impact" and one indicated the proposed testing timeframes were not suitable as work on their delivery is on hold, pending the rule change deferral decision.</li> <li>A further two comments agree with the proposal: <ol> <li>No issue with bringing it forward, and</li> <li>It's desirable to have the environment available in Nov 2020 for testing purposes.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Several additional questions and suggestions were made about the approach for AEMO to consider and respond to.</li> </ul>
4	What other changes to the proposed deployment timeframe would assist in mitigating any impacts?	<ul> <li>Three responded with no impact or anything further to add. An additional three suggested AEMO:</li> <li>1) Seeks more details of specific industry testing scope, participation and approach, and</li> <li>2) Defer the implementation slightly and reduce the dispatch transition period by one month.</li> </ul>
5	Would deferring AEMO's acceptance of 5- minute MDFF files to 1 April 2021 impact your 5MS program?	Five responded, "no impact" and one commented they will be reviewing the full testing lifecycle, including what AEMO has included.
6	Does the changed order of systems deployment impact your program?	Five responded, "no impact", but two noted that settlements and dispatch deployment risks could impact MDM deployment. One did not enter a response to this question.
7	Does the proposed testing approach provide enough opportunity for proving participant's 5MS systems and processes?	<ul> <li>Three responded that the testing approach is adequate and two expressed the following concerns:</li> <li>1) About not having B2B in staging impacting bilateral testing</li> <li>2) If AEMO doesn't run a market trial before the Dispatch Platform is implemented, there won't be enough opportunities for regression testing and identifying issues prior to go live.</li> </ul>

# 12 month deferral rule change proposal

- Responses to AEMC consultation on proposed 12-month deferral are due 11-Jun-20
- Objections to the proposed urgent rule change process due 28-May-20
- AEMC scheduled to publish a final determination by 9-Jul-20
- AEMO has worked with participants to identify a transition and testing scenario for a 12-month deferral

### Next steps:

 Subject to the decision being received on 9-Jul-20, AEMO proposes to hold a special RWG / PCF to review the consequences for 5MS industry timelines and identify the steps required to achieve certainty as soon as possible.

### Industry Risks and Issues Register

- As discussed at PCF#21, the proposed 12 month deferral makes it difficult to meaningfully review the Industry Risks and Issues register, as there are at least 2 scenarios: no deferral and 12 month deferral
- Propose to schedule a review during August PCF which will capture any risks and issues resulting from AEMC decision on 12-month deferral proposal
- Purpose of today is to review new risks and identify any risks or issues that should be raised at the Executive Forum.

# Industry Readiness Report 2 – Survey response and coverage



- Strong survey response with a large increase in respondents in round 2 of reporting. Level of industry coverage provides sound basis for overall readiness assessment.
  - 40 organisations responded to the second round of readiness reporting, representing an even mix of participant types. An additional 16 new organisations participated in round 2 of reporting.
  - High coverage of the industry, ranging from 88 100% across participant types
  - Metering Coordinators were invited to report on their readiness in the second round of reporting and future rounds of reporting

### Readiness Reporting Round 2 – Commentary (1)

Overall industry progress and status remains at 1-25% and on-track, consistent with Overall program • round 1. The downtrend reflects the number of response categories where subsets of participants are indicating emergent risks, issues and heightened uncertainty in comparison to the previous survey. Program delivery of 5MS and GS has progressed across the industry, with 27% of the Status: On track industry now at 25-49% progress or more, compared to 8% two months ago in the previous round of reporting. Majority are on track, with 5 respondents noting that Trend: 🞝 their program is at risk or late. Progress: 1-24% An emerging theme among responses highlights the uncertainty created because of complete the rule change proposal, and varying degrees of impact from COVID-19. At the time of publication, AEMO notes that AEMC is still finalising rule change timelines, and that various 5MS working groups have are currently considering the potential impacts of the rule change. Overall general criteria Majority of participants have secured project funding, established project plans and project governance, and have onboarded project teams. The proportion of established programs is comparable to round 1, due to new respondents in round 2 having comparatively less established programs. Status: On track

- Participants are progressing with activities in the Metering transition plan (MTP), with a few items requiring AEMO confirmation and follow up to address recovery approaches for delayed activities.
  - AEMO raised the follow items for discussion at the TFG on 6 May 2020
    - $\circ$   $\,$  MP and MC meter installation and reconfiguration activities for S01 S05  $\,$
    - MDP metering data delivery activities for S17 S20
    - o MP MSATS Standing Data Creation and Maintenance in S39
    - $\circ$   $\,$  MP and MDP Metering accreditation update activities for S40 S44  $\,$
- MPs and MDPs still reporting 'n/a' to a large number of metering transition plan activities
- Survey coverage of MPs responsible for BULK/ Wholesale NMIs is now at 100% compared to 54% in previous round of reporting.
  - Essential metering reported as "on track"
  - A subset of respondents in this category reporting "at risk"
- Some participants are providing status reporting of MTP activities in way that does not reflect the defined transition end dates. (E.g. Reporting that an activity status is "On track not started" for activities where the transition end date has passed.)
  - **Discussion**: What are participants' experiences when providing MTP related reporting? Are there any suggestions for AEMO to provide additional support with this process to align reporting with the MTP?



# Readiness Reporting – Actions in progress

- Participants who have reported programs as "At risk" or "Late" will have targeted follow up to understand remediation activities to be implemented
  - Focus on MP's/ MC's/ MDPs for essential metering
- Targeted follow up of participants who did not respond to 2<sup>nd</sup> round of reporting
- Refinement of N/A response rationale to identify respondent scope issues.

## "Minimum criteria" and go/no-go decisions: Approach

Assessment undertaken as component of 5MS/GS Industry readiness contingency planning:

- 1. Established critical elements for 5MS commencement:
  - Essential meters to be in place at rule commencement
  - Assess essential capability for each major participant group to be in place at rule commencement to enable market operations to continue with integrity and without interruption
    - Essential capability is a subset of participant readiness reporting criteria i.e. it is different from the **total** capability required for **compliance** with the 5MS and GS rules
- 2. Assessed essential capability against system go-live and rule commencement decisions

#### Next Steps

    - Proposing to publish the minutes as draft when we circulate to the Working Group / Forum

  - Alignment of information across working groups
    - As the AEMO systems deployment progresses, AEMO and participants are becoming more focused on readiness activities. AEMO is undertaking a review of the working group structure to identify a more streamlined approach to disseminating information for this phase of the program and facilitating focused discussions with the appropriate experts on the call.
    - This approach will also aim to provide an improvement in the consistency and clarity of the timelines. Alignment between RWG and SWG will be a key area of focus.
    - AEMO will discuss possible options with working groups and present a proposal to the PCF in July
