AEMO Competition Law Meeting Protocol

AEMO is committed to complying with all applicable laws, including the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (CCA). In any dealings with AEMO regarding proposed reforms or other initiatives, all participants agree to adhere to the CCA at all times and to comply with this Protocol. Participants must arrange for their representatives to be briefed on competition law risks and obligations.

Participants in AEMO discussions must:

- 1. Ensure that discussions are limited to the matters contemplated by the agenda for the discussion
- 2. Make independent and unilateral decisions about their commercial positions and approach in relation to the matters under discussion with AEMO
- 3. Immediately and clearly raise an objection with AEMO or the Chair of the meeting if a matter is discussed that the participant is concerned may give rise to competition law risks or a breach of this Protocol

Participants in AEMO meetings **must not** discuss or agree on the following topics:

- 1. Which customers they will supply or market to
- 2. The price or other terms at which Participants will supply
- 3. Bids or tenders, including the nature of a bid that a Participant intends to make or whether the Participant will participate in the bid
- 4. Which suppliers Participants will acquire from (or the price or other terms on which they acquire goods or services)
- 5. Refusing to supply a person or company access to any products, services or inputs they require

Under no circumstances must Participants share Competitively Sensitive Information. Competitively Sensitive Information means confidential information relating to a Participant which if disclosed to a competitor could affect its current or future commercial strategies, such as pricing information, customer terms and conditions, supply terms and conditions, sales, marketing or procurement strategies, product development, margins, costs, capacity or production planning.



AEMO

- The fifth meeting of the MSDR Focus Group occurred on Thursday 7 April
- The agenda included:
 - Key Milestones Update
 - Targeted BUT Pre-prod and Prod BUT dates, mentioned in MSDR FG #3, will unfortunately not be able to be met due to:
 - Increased effort associated to the development of the 3 native APIs
 - · Unexpected key resource unavailability
 - Revised SIPF Update Plans will be requested from LNSPs once revised BUT dates have been confirmed
 - AEMO Blind Script Approach
 - Update existing values in the applicable CATS table to reflect the applicable valid procedural values
 - AEMO and FG members to ensure that the updates do not alter the meaning/intent of any existing data in the effected records
 - These updates would be <u>blind</u> script updates
 - No notifications would be generated to effected participants.
 - The updates <u>would not</u> be included in the C1 reports
 - AEMO would share the tested SQL script (or perhaps a pseudo script) with all participants as a means of assisting them in keeping their data in sync with MSATS

MCPI/MSDR Update



BUT Configurable Items

- BUT ONCE
 - When set, it indicates that a BUT update can only be executed once against Standing Data by a submitting Participant ID for that 'Field ID' and Business Key*
- CURRENT IS NULL
 - When set, it indicates that a BUT update can only be executed if the current Standing Data record's value for the nominated 'Field ID' and Business Key is NULL.
- NEW NOT NULL
 - When set, it indicates that the new/supplied 'Value' cannot be NULL for the corresponding BUT CSV Submission 'Field ID'.
- MSDR Data Transition Table/Plan
 - Members had varying views re a number of field transition end dates
 - Completion of the transition to Structured Addresses is viewed as the key priority
 - 5 additional fields to be added to the MSDR Data Transition Table:
 - 3 relating to the BUT's configurable items
 - 1 relating to the field's priority
 - 1 relating to field groupings
 - A subgroup of the MSDR FG has been formed to initially populate 5 new fields
 - The updated MSDR Data Transition Table will be circulated to the MSDR FG 2 weeks prior to the next MSDR FG for consideration and feedback
- Next MSDR FG meeting scheduled for Monday 23 May



Industry Test / Market Trial Update

Strong representation from impacted participants in Industry Testing and Market Trial

All planned Global Settlement runs successfully completed

- Reschedule of run timing due to environment issues and at participant request
- No defects identified in settlement process
 - Participant noted differences due to:
 - GS calculation v/s Settlement by Difference
 - Metering data differences between prod and pre-prod environments
 - Data "cleanup" activity and timing in prod and pre-prod
- Defect identified in RM Reports (43/46) for calculation of ADMELA and consequently UFEF

Updated CR Processes for MCPI and GS tested via Industry Test

Minor defects for backdated NMI create resolved

GS Transition

- Pre-prod used to confirm likely production run times
- All NMIs successfully updated to reflect Global Settlement transition
- Defects identified with reconciliation reports which required reports to be re-run
 - Exceptions noted in reports due to backdating of "glopool" updates for Market trial and timing of report process will not occur in production

GS Market Trial Summary Outcomes



Defects Outstanding for Go-Live

- Issue 239 Mismatch in UFEF for RM reports (ADMELA)
 - Impacts calculation of ADMELA in Profile Areas with generation within embedded networks. Settlement process confirmed as correct, but RM reports will not exactly reconcile UFEA
 - Timeframe for fix deployment to be determined. Will have expedited release to prod and available for test in pre-prod


Conclusion:
