Suffix survey results (12 responses):

Do you have data for interval meters that you will need to change to match the consistent approach adopted?

- 10/12 said yes, 3 of which had caveats
- Several respondents aren't already using the consistent approach
- One response stated "As a retailer, we are not responsible for maintaining meter configuration standing data in MSATS. However we will be required to update our internal systems in response to changes to match the consistent approach."
- Most respondents need to update their approach and have not built this into their 5MS/GS IT project
- Significant number of NMs and registers will need to be updated
- Unknown timeframe to adopt the change. "Low to medium cost" but overall a beneficial change to make
- Participants somewhat interested in AEMO's help with mass data update
- Some of those who answered yes regarding the prior question do have a mapping of current Register ID to datastream suffix or this could be provided
